

## INTRODUCTION

SynSisal<sup>®</sup> weaves are tailor-made with the unique ECONYL<sup>®</sup> StayClean fiber. This solution-dyed Nylon 6 fiber is made from 100% regenerated nylon and guarantees maximum cleanability and durability for the lifespan of the carpet. Stain-free carpets have never been so easy to maintain with the new ECONYL<sup>®</sup> tailor-made StayClean fiber. Because stain protection is permanently built into ECONYL<sup>®</sup> StayClean fiber, carpets can be stained and washed effectively with water or more potent cleansing agents without losing the anti-stain properties.

## GENERAL CARE ADVICE

- Vacuuming regularly to reduce soil buildup will prolong the life of the floor covering.
- Ensure the vacuum beater bar is properly adjusted. Damage can occur to the carpet fibers if the brushes of the vacuum are set too low.

## CLEANING GUIDELINES

- Vacuum regularly.
- Remove spills immediately using water-only, absorbing any liquids with a clean white towel or cloth.
- Continue to rinse and blot with water. Vacuum extraction can also be used to remove excess liquids.
- Professionally clean annually. Do not apply stain-repellent treatments that contain silicone because they tend to accelerate carpet soiling.

## SPOT REMOVAL TREATMENT

One of the most crucial areas of carpet maintenance is the removal of spots and spills. Acting quickly when anything is spilled or dropped, and always having the necessary cleaning materials on hand are of the utmost importance.

- Scoop up solids first. Immediately blot (do not rub) spills with a clean white towel or absorbent cloth working from the edges to the center to prevent the spill from spreading.
- Rinse with clear water on a clean cloth. Remove excess moisture by applying pressure with an absorbent cloth.
- Once the water has removed the spot, blot excess moisture by applying pressure with paper towels or a dry absorbent cloth.
- Do not over-saturate with water.
- If stain is unable to be removed by water-only treatment, use an oxidizing agent on the stain. Be sure to remove any excess cleaner with a vacuum.

- Rinse with clear water on a clean cloth. Remove excess moisture by applying pressure with a clean white towel or absorbent cloth.
- Repeat as much as needed until the stain is lifted.
