

## CARE & CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SYNTHETIC SEAGRASS

Our Synthetic Seagrass looks just like the real thing. It is easy to keep it looking like new when following these guidelines and helpful tips.

- **Soil Prevention:** Avoid bringing dirt in from outside. Use of mats to remove debris and moisture off shoes and have the capability to hold that material. Also keep in mind that dark carpets show dirt and stains less than light carpets.
- **Routine Care and Cleaning:** Daily vacuuming with a brush-type vacuum cleaner removes the loose and slightly abrasive dirt and is particularly important for commercially used carpets and in high traffic areas if used residentially.
- **Stain Removal:** Stains should always be removed immediately. The longer they are left on the face of the carpet the more likely they will become a permanent stain.
  1. First scoop up the stain solids immediately using a blunt object or spoon.
  2. Subsequently soak up the liquid spill with an absorbent towel. If residual particles are still embedded in the structure of the carpet, use lukewarm water and a clean white cloth, working from the edges of the stain towards the center to avoid spreading the substance causing the stain.
  3. After removing the dirt, take a dry white towel and by blotting remove as much of the remaining moisture as possible.
  4. Then dry the area as quickly as possible, use a fan or a hairdryer set on a low temperature.
- **Overall Cleaning:** To preserve the quality and performance of your carpet we recommend your carpet is cleaned professionally.
- **Before cleaning,** vacuum the carpet thoroughly with a brush-type vacuum cleaner. We recommend three possible cleaning methods: spray extraction, shampooing or dry powder cleaning (Host Dry Cleaning). As there are a large number of cleaning agents on the market, we would like to point out that a pH neutral, non-film forming cleaning agents should be used as far as possible.
